The organizers do not provide transportation during the competition.




Embargoed areas

According to the IOF Competition Rules (§ 26.5) any attempt for all potential athletes, team officials, and other persons, to survey or train in the competition terrain is forbidden (with or without map), unless explicitly permitted by the organiser. Attempts to gain any information related to the courses, beyond that provided by the organiser, is forbidden before and during the competition.

Entry to the area for other purposes (visiting institutions, accommodation, etc.) is not prohibited, if necessary.

Hard floor accommodation will be provided on Thursday night after the race.

Price: 2800 HUF / person

The organizers do not provide food or catering during the competition.

Punching and timekeeping

SPORTident Air+ system will be used. Non-contactless SPORTident chips can also be used.

SIAC chips can be hired for 800 HUF/runner.

SI-Card 8 can be hired for 500 HUF/runner.

In categories 10C, 12C and 14E the SI-Card 8 hiring is free.

The classes participating in the Sprint League (18E, 20E, 21E) run the same course, but different for each gender.

Race 2

Format	Mass start sprint / individual sprint
Ranking	Non ranking competition

Race 2 will be held exclusively in the M/W 14E, 16E, 18E, 20E and 21E categories.

The first race serves as a qualifier in these categories for this race. Depending on the number of entries, 6-person finals will be held with a mass start. A maximum of 3 final groups were formed per category. Spreading method **course choice** will be applied.

Competitors who do not get into the final groups can run their course out of the competition with a condensed individual start. The course combination is randomly assigned to them, they have no choice.

The overall result of the competition is given by the placings of the final race. The ranking of competitors who do not reach the final is determined based on their ranking in the qualifiers.
