Categories **Long Distance Championship:**

National championship categories

M/W 14E, 16E, 18E, 20E, 21E (also IOF World Ranking Event - WRE) 35A, 40A, 45A, 50A, 55A, 60A, 65A, 70A, 75A, 80A, F85A

Open, non-championship categories: open challenge short, open challenge long, open beginner.

Score Team Championship:

National championship categories (3-member teams):

M/W 14A, 16A, 18A, 20A, 21A, 105A, 125A, 145A, 165A, 185A, **M** 205A

The masters categories are open to those who were born in 1988 or earlier. The total age of the three competitors (total ages reached in 2023) must reach at least the number in the category name.

Open, non-championship categories:

Open Challenge Short, Open Challenge Long, Open Beginner.

Participation in all categories, except the Open categories, requires a valid national competition licence, daily or annual. The date of the competition licence check by the Hungarian Orienteering Federation: 6th of October 2023 (Friday). The entry system will check the existence of the annual competition licence at the moment of entry. In case of absence, the daily competition licence fee will be charged automatically.

The registrant is responsible for deducting the daily entry fee by pressing the "Recalculate" button on the entry form.

The championships are also open to foreign (not Hungarian) competitors and teams. However, in the case of the Hungarian Long Distance Championship, the results of only the competitors of Hungarian nationality from member organisations of the Hungarian Orienteering Federation will count in the Hungarian Championship. In the case of the Hungarian Score Team Championship, teams with up to one competitor with a non-Hungarian nationality from member organisations of the Hungarian Orienteering Federation will count in the Hungarian Championship's results.

Entry deadline:

In Championship categories: **2nd October 2023, midnight**

In the Open categories: **9th October 2023**. After the deadline, entries will be accepted only at the on-site entry prices and only for the empty places.

Entering the team members by name is only possible until **8:00 a.m., 15th October 2023**, via the E-Registration system only.

Entries are subject to payment!


Punching system:

SPORTident punching system will be used.

Contactless SPORTident Air+ function will also be turned on, and the SI-stations can also be used in contactless mode with SIAC-cards.

Terrain, Map: The terrain is 350-530 m above sea level and can be characterised by distinctive landforms with deep valleys in places and steep hillsides. Mainly hornbeam-beech forest, runability and visibility are typically very good. The running speed is only reduced by crossing the valleys. The terrain has a road network of medium density.
Most of the terrain has not yet been mapped.

Scales: 1:10 000 and 1:7500, contour interval 5 m both, printed on waterproof paper
LIDAR-based map, made by Tibor Erdélyi in 2022-2023. Standard ISOM 2017-2.



Embargoed areas:

All embargoed areas marked on the following map remain embargoed until the day of the competition. It is forbidden to enter for all competitors, coaches and spectators. Violation of these rules will result in disqualification.

Prizes and Awards:

The winners of each Championship category will be awarded the title of Long Distance Champion of Hungary and the title of Score Team Champion of Hungary award. The 1st-3rd place winners will be awarded medals and honour prizes. On the Long Distance Championship in the W/M 14-21 categories, certificates will award the 4th-6th place winners. Open categories will not be awarded.

Entry permits to Hungary:

Entry to Hungary from the European Union and most other countries is visa-free. Visa is required for entry from certain Asian, African, and American countries.

Other information:

- Commercial activities are only possible with the permission of the organisers at the Event.
- The relevant provisions of the IOF Competition Rules shall be applied to organisational issues.
- We will organise kindergarten for the children on both days.
- Please run with your safety in mind. Everybody attends the competition at their own risk.
- All persons taking part in the Event must have respect for the Fairplay rules.
- We kindly ask all competitors and spectators to follow sustainability-conscious behaviour and minimise their carbon footprints. Please bring your own cup for the refreshments and leave no litter behind.
- There will be media service at the Event. All participants in the Event, including competitors and spectators, agree that photos, videos, and recordings of the Event– in the absence of written contrary declaration – can be published in the printed and electronic media, including the TV and Internet.
